Program Highlights

What the Online Program Offers

- The program is fully online including placement testing, registration, payment, all coursework and full access to an instructor
- The program offers individualized learning plans based on placement testing
- The program is available to students nationally and internationally
- Students can work from home or anywhere that they can access the internet
- Students can complete their course work at any time of the day
- Students gain full acceptance to the SHU English Language Institute
- Upon completion of all necessary courses, students will receive an SHU Certificate of Completion and gain eligibility to apply for conditional acceptance to SHU's undergraduate and graduate programs
- Upon completion of the program, students will be prepared to take the TOEFL, IELTS or PTE exam

What the Program Includes

- Students can have all program levels completed in 16 months if enrolled continuously in all four levels.
- Students have full access to an instructor through email, Skype and the online classroom during their coursework.
- Each program level includes activities that have been designed to practice different skills and to test your progress on each of the skills with an End-of-Level Test
- The program levels are broken down into units and each unit contains presentations and activities in listening, speaking, reading, writing, vocabulary, pronunciation and grammar
- Within each program level, the directions for coursework can be translated into a student's native language.
- A dictionary, glossary, and grammar reference are available for all levels within the program
- Students will need: access to a computer, internet access, a computer microphone for speaking activities, and computer speakers for listening activities
