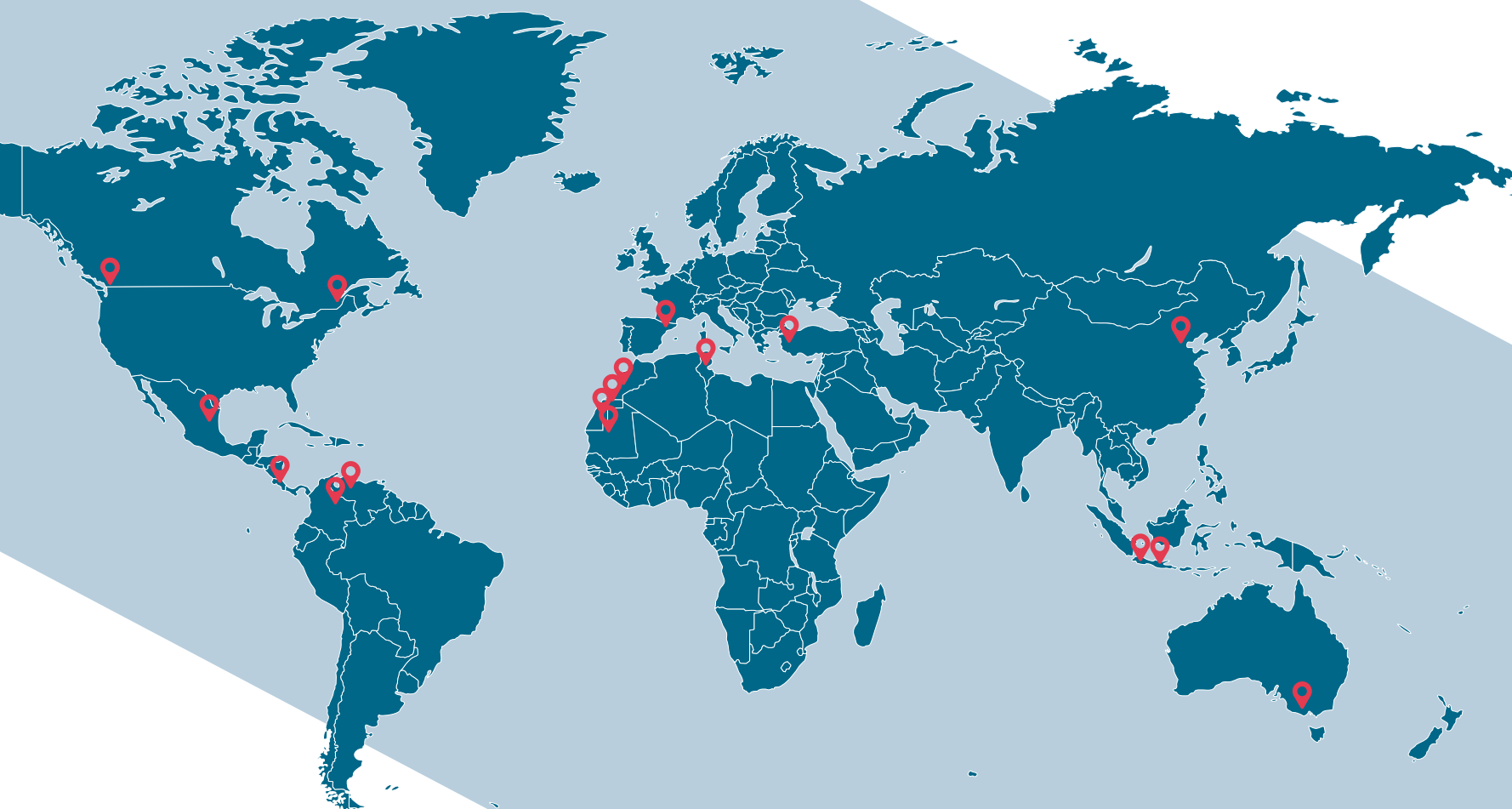

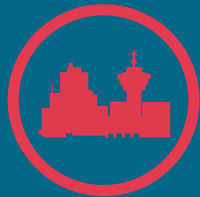

COURSES

General English

Ideal for students who want to improve their overall English language proficiency for general purposes and gain confidence to communicate effectively in real life situations.

Following a dynamic and interactive approach, students do a range of every day speaking, listening, writing and reading activities. The aim of this course is to help students activate

learned grammar structure and vocabulary in speaking, and increase confidence to communicate effectively.

English for Effective Communication (EEC) Diploma Program is also available for advanced-level students to further develop their communications skills in public speaking, presentations, and work-related functions.

The diploma program is a 4-week part-time course and can be combined with another course for a full-time program.

Listening & Pronunciation

Through specific listening exercises, students work to improve not only their listening comprehension skills but also their vocabulary and use of idioms and expressions.

Students also learn about the English sound system, rhythm, intonation, and how sounds are linked together. Students are guided to make self-corrections and to focus on clear

pronunciation during in-class activities, allowing students to improve articulation and reduce accents.

Academic English

This course allows students to improve their reading skills and accuracy in both spoken and written English. A wide variety of reading texts are studied in detail.

The diversity in content exposes students to a broad range of vocabulary and grammar, as well as different literature forms.

After successful completing the Academic English course, students can take the pathway to one of the many universities or colleges we have academic partnerships with, including LAB's partner and sister-institution, LaSalle College Vancouver.

IELTS Preparation

Designed to teach different techniques and strategies to help students fully demonstrate their language ability on the exam.

Prepare to succeed in the IELTS test! This course is designed to help students who plan to take the IELTS exam in the near future.

The course will help students become familiar with the requirements of the exam and its four sections: Reading, Listening, Writing and Speaking.

Students will practice each of these skills extensively, as well

as focus on improving their grammar, vocabulary, spelling, punctuation and pronunciation.

Students will also learn exam-writing strategies and techniques, such as time-management, and will have the opportunity to take full practice exams to review their knowledge and familiarize themselves with the test style.

COURSES

Business English

The aim of this program is to build on a student's previous education and experiences, giving greater insight into business from an international perspective. Students will increase their confidence to communicate effectively in English at school, with coworkers and supervisors, and with foreign business partners.

How to apply to LaSalle College Vancouver

To study at LaSalle College Vancouver, international students must achieve an equivalent Academic IELTS score of 5.5 (with no skill band less than 5.0) for certificate and diploma programs, or 6.5 (with no skill band less than 6.0) for Bachelor degrees.

1. Apply in 1 step: apply directly to LaSalle College Vancouver, following the entry criteria and requirements. If your application is successful, LaSalle College Vancouver will issue you a conditional offer to study one of their programs. You will also be automatically offered a place to study first at LAB in Vancouver.

OR

2. Apply in 2 steps: apply first to LAB in Vancouver to improve your English to the required level; then we will help you apply to LaSalle College Vancouver.

4. You will be assigned an Admissions Advisor, who will review your application.
5. LAB in Vancouver will email you a Letter of Acceptance. Canadian immigration will require you to show this document when applying for a student visa.
6. Apply for your Canadian student or visitor visa.
7. Make a payment via bank transfer, credit card or in person at LAB in Vancouver's campus. The amount required, and details of how to pay, are included in your invoice.
