

Programs for International Students



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English Language Program (ELP)

The ELP at California State University, San Bernardino (CSUSB) program, is designed for those seeking an intensive English experience focusing on reading, writing, listening/speaking English, as well as an introduction to American culture. The program focuses on providing the academic English language skills needed to meet the requirements for admission into the university's undergraduate or graduate programs.

About the program

- 10 weeks of instruction
- 4-5 hours per day, 5 days per week (4 days per week in summer)
- Admission requirements: at least 18 years of age and high school graduate or approval of International Extension Program staff.

We offer classes for all levels

The ELP prepares you for academic work at the university level. The curriculum consists of six levels, beginner through advanced, as well as a graduate studies level. The beginner through upper-intermediate levels are divided into four core areas including Grammar, Composition, Reading and Listening/Speaking. The advanced level consists of four core areas; Advanced Grammar, Composition, Listening/Speaking and University Study Skills. The graduate studies level focuses on Advanced TOEFL Preparation, Advanced Academic Composition and Oral Language development.



All students are required to take a three-part placement test upon entrance. The placement test consists of an oral interview, written composition and a standardized multiple choice exam. Students are placed in a level of instruction based on the test results.

Conditional Admission

Conditional Admission to CSUSB is available to international students who meet all university entrance requirements* except for the minimum English scores.

CSUSB requires the following English scores for admission:

- Undergraduates: TOEFL 500 (61 Internet-based) or IELTS 5.5
- Graduates: TOEFL 550 (79/80 Internet-based) or IELTS 6.0

Steps to Apply for a Conditional Admission

- 1. Submit the English Language Program (ELP) application. Complete the ELP and I-20 application on the following website: http://global.csusb.edu/English-Language-Program/ELP-apply.html.
- 2. Submit the \$120 ELP application fee.
- Submit the International Application for the University. Complete the university application on the following website <u>www.csumentor.edu</u>.
- 4. Submit the \$55 university application fee with application on **www.csumentor.edu**.
- 5. Submit official transcripts or mark sheets, and proof of graduation or a diploma.
- 6. Submit an updated financial/bank statement.
- **7.** Submit a copy of your passport.

Degrees requiring official TOEFL or IELTS scores

- Master of Arts in Communication Studies
- Master of Arts in English Composition
- Master of Arts in Special Education
- Master of Science in Biology

Study Abroad in the USA

This program allows you to enroll in university degree-credit courses at the undergraduate level on a space-available basis and study alongside American students.

Academic credits earned at CSUSB may be transferred to your home institution and be counted toward degree requirements.

You may enroll in 10, 20 or 30 weeks of study at the undergraduate level with 12 units of credit per quarter. Graduate level courses require special permission.

Requirements

- TOEFL score of 500 (61 Internet-based) or IELTS 5.5
- A letter of permission from your home university
- A completed I-20 visa form
