NZCEL Level 1

- Nationally recognised qualifications: NZCEL Level 1
- Students have confidence in dealing with simple daily topics

- Nationally recognised qualifications: NZCEL Level 2
- Students have confidence in dealing with English on familiar topics

NZCEL Level 3

- Nationally recognised qualifications: NZCEL 3
- Direct entry to some certificate programmes (Level 3 or 4 tertiary study) on academic strand
- Students have confidence in dealing with English accurately and fluently on familiar topics

NZCEL Level 4

- Nationally recognised qualifications: NZCEL 4
- Direct entry to some diploma, bachelor, and graduate programmes (Level 4, 5, 6 and 7 tertiary study) on academic strand
- Students have confidence in dealing with English on familiar and unfamiliar topics

NZCEL Level 5

- Nationally recognised qualifications: NZCEL 5
- Direct entry to some postgraduate diploma, degree, and master programmes (Level 8 tertiary study) on academic strand
- Students have confidence in dealing accurately with a wide range of topics in English at academic, social, and employment level

ENGLISH LANGUAGE TRAINING

For students who wish to study English but do not require a qualification. Students will be studying alongside NZCEL students. Course content is the same as NZCEL.

IELTS PREPARATION OPTION

IELTS preparation classes are offered as a part time option for those studying the NZCEL Level 3 and Level 4 programmes.

IELTS preparation classes are designed to improve students' test taking strategies, to familiarise students with the IELTS test format, and to improve their English level prior to taking the test. Out of class study is strongly encouraged, to include practice in tasks one and two of the writing module as well as reading and listening tests which students are able to borrow to use at home.

Near their exam date, each student is given a practice speaking test.

NEW ZEALAND CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE (NZCEL) & ENGLISH LANGUAGE TRAINING 2016

EIT is a registered British Council IELTS Testing Centre, so students can sit the IELTS test here.

ASSESSMENTS

NZCEL

Assessments vary for each course, but include assignments, practical and written assessments, role-plays, verbal presentations. Assessment assistance is available through the EIT Learning Hub for everyone to prepare and perform well.

Some courses include assessment against National Qualifications Framework unit standards.

IELTS EXAM

EIT is a registered British Council Centre offering exams throughout the year. The exam fee is NZ\$ 385.00

ENTRY POINT

Students will take an online test before starting the programme to determine English level and entry point.

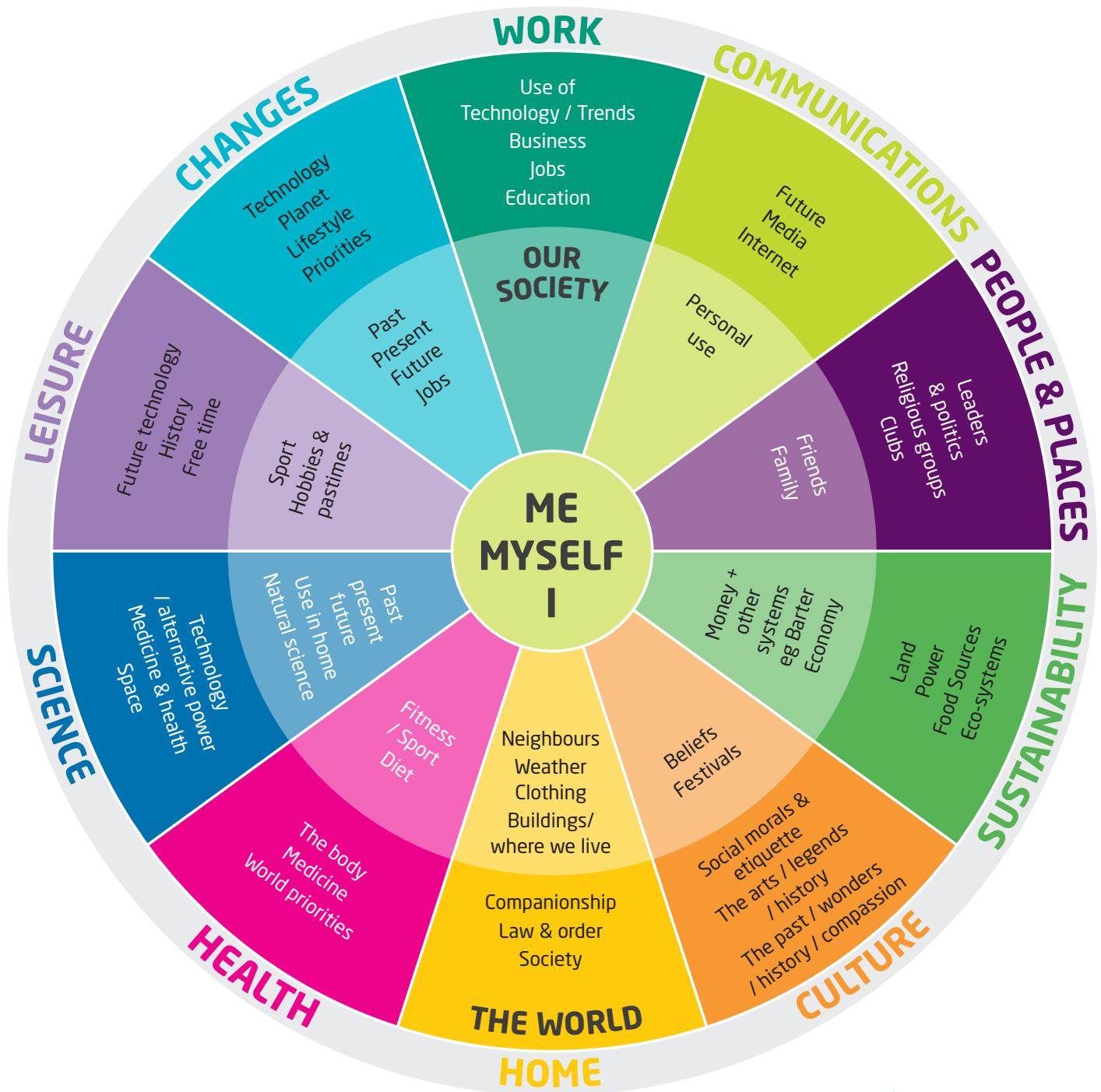
On arrival, students will have an oral and written assessment to confirm their level of English in order for them to be placed in an appropriate class.

WHAT IS NZCEL?

New Zealand Certificates in English Language (NZCEL) qualifications are intended for learners of English as an additional language. They are suitable for all types of students, beginners to advanced. It is for people who want to progress to further academic study or if you simply want to improve your English.

WHAT TYPES OF ENGLISH COURSES ARE AVAILABLE?

We teach English to all levels and abilities, from beginners to advanced. EIT offers general and academic English courses.

1. **Academic courses** - (i) You can either study NZCEL, which is an academic pathway to an EIT academic programme, or (ii) you can study an IELTS course and take the IELTS test at the end.
2. **General courses** - These can be used for personal development; for example, to help you get a better job or to help you communicate better while you live in New Zealand. Our general English courses are called an English Language Training Scheme.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. WHAT LEVEL IS RIGHT FOR ME?

You may already know your ability, but to make sure you join the right class, you will be assessed before you start your English course. Assessment is by our Online Placement Test, or you can provide an IELTS result if you already have one. EIT will contact you once you have accepted an offer to study at EIT to organise the Online Placement Test.

2. WHAT IS NZCEL?

New Zealand Certificates in English Language.

3. HOW LONG DO I NEED TO STUDY?

Our general English courses are for a minimum of 4 weeks and our academic English courses are for a minimum of 16 weeks.

4. CAN I STUDY MORE THAN ONE COURSE?

Yes you can. If you pass one NZCEL programme you can move to the next level.

5. DO I GET A QUALIFICATION AT THE END OF MY COURSE?

You will receive a nationally recognised qualification if you pass one of our NZCEL or IELTS academic courses, and a certificate of attendance for completing one of our general English courses.

6. HOW MANY STUDENTS IN A CLASS?

There are usually between 8-12 students in each class.

7. IS THERE ACCOMMODATION AVAILABLE IN NAPIER?

Yes. There is a range of accommodation options. Please see pages 42/43.
