Whether you are a student hoping to immerse yourself in an Arabic speaking environment or a mid-career professional with specific language goals, our mission is to help you achieve the level of attainment that you desire. Students are sure to find the tools necessary to meet their particular needs.

Qualified Instructors

One of the primary reasons that students continue to choose us is due to the high standards held by our instructors. Educators are selected through a multi-level application process which evaluates their experience and education, while undergoing observation and in-house instruction. Our instructors currently hold higher degrees and have extensive teaching experience.

Accredited Teaching Standards

Our center maintains a high standard of instruction, and adheres to the International Guidelines on the teaching of foreign languages. These guidelines, enhanced by our many years of experience have shown us the most effective methods of teaching Arabic. Students will receive official transcripts indicating the content of the course studied so they can claim credit at their universities. If our students wish to pursue Arabic more intensively, we offer a diverse private teaching staff which can be paired to specifically meet our students' requests.







Arabic Language Courses

One of the leading reasons that students continue to choose IH Amman due to the various courses we offer. Whether it is Modern Standard or Colloquial Arabic, an intensive or extensive approach, you are sure to find the right classroom to fit your needs. Our group and Private courses each have their advantages depending on the specific goals of each student.

Modern Standard Arabic (Fus'ha)

Modern Standard Arabic is the official Arabic language. It can be written and spoken, and there is no difference between the written and the spoken form. In its written form, Modern Standard Arabic is the language of literature and the media in the Arab world. These courses include the four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) and covered at varying degrees in all levels. The main textbooks used at the center are 'Al-Kitaab Series' (Alif Baa, Al-Kitaab I,II,III) supplemented by other materials and activities.

Colloquial Arabic (Ammiya)

There is no doubt that Colloquial Arabic (Ammiya) differs from the Modern Standard one in various aspects; expressions used and also the structure of sentences itself.

As a result, here at IH Amman Colloquial Arabic courses enjoys the same level of importance as the Modern Standard Arabic. The text used for these courses, "Yalla Ndardish", has been selected carefully to satisfy our students' needs. The focus of the book is one the colloquial Arabic spoken in the Levant region which includes Jordan, Palestine, Syria and Lebanon. The colloquial Arabic spoken in other Arab countries can also be offered, upon request.

Specialized Arabic Courses

At IH Amman, we believe that students' needs are highly important and so we do offer specialized Arabic Courses like; Media Arabic, Economics, and Business Communication.

IH Amman offers Arabic courses in two settings; group courses and private courses.

Group Arabic Courses

Group courses are organized throughout the year. In principle, new group courses start on the first Sunday of every month. In a group course, a total of 20 contact hours of modern standard Arabic (MSA) is covered every week. Students may register for any duration ranging from one week only to a whole year. A student sits for a placement test on the first day of the course to determine the group course he or she should join. Three language levels of each group course are offered : the beginners level, the intermediate level, and the advanced level. The three levels are further subdivided into sub-levels. Depending on the level and the date of offering, groups are usually small, and they typically range from 2 to 8 students in one group.

Private Arabic Course

Our students can also benefit from our tailor made courses, especially if they are tending to have their course privately. Here the student can determine the course length and its start and end dates solely, so private courses are offered at any time of the year. The content of the private course will be decided by the instructor based on the language needs of the students. The course may focus on Modern Standard Arabic, Media Arabic, Business Arabic, Classical Arabic, Colloquial Arabic, etc.

Online Arabic Courses

The school offers students and professionals the opportunity to apply for online skype courses in Arabic Language. An online Skype course can be organized in a one-to-one setting only. Course content will be decided by the instructor based on the language needs of the student. The time of the online sessions shall be negotiated by the instructor and student before the first session. The time will take into consideration the time difference between Jordan and the country of residence of the student.

Accommodation

IH Amman will help to coordinate housing, dining and any other needs that might occur while our guests are in Jordan. We offer several accommodation options to its students. Our staff is eager to assist with housing needs so that you may focus on your primary goal of attaining Arabic.

Students Residence

Students of all ages have the option of staying in all-males or all-females student residences located within a walking distance from the center. At the residence, each student will have his or her own studio (bedroom, bathroom, and kitchenette). Internet services are offered for free in most residences. No meals are served, however, students can cook in their kitchenette or eat at the restaurants located near the dorms.



Students House

A student house is a shared apartment having one or more bedrooms, a bathroom, a kitchen, and a living area. The bedrooms and facilities of the apartment are shared. Each bedroom may accommodate one or two persons. Internet connectivity is provided in most student houses. No meals are served, however, the neighborhood has many restaurants. This option is suitable for individual students, or a group of 2 or 3 students wishing to stay together.



Private Apartments

A private apartment has one bedroom, a bathroom, a kitchenette, a small living area, an air-condition or fan, TV, and a study desk. Internet connectivity is provided in most apartments, however, students may also buy cheap Internet USB sticks if Internet connectivity is weak or unavailable. No meals are served, however, the neighborhood has many restaurants.







Homestays

The center gives female students the chance to stay with local host families. A host family provides a bedroom, two meals, and of course, the cultural exchange experience. Families live in different parts of Amman, and the average Taxi drive to the center from most host families is in the range 20 - 15 minutes. Due to cultural issues, only a few families accept male students, and therefore, male students may apply for this option, however, availability at the time of application may not always be guaranteed.


