LOCATION OF PROGRAMME

The programme uses Global School of English -Edinburgh to provide the morning English language lessons, Monday to Friday. Global school is situated in an unbeatable city centre location, on York Place, we are just 5 minutes' walk from the main shopping area of Princes Street and close to all of Edinburgh's top attractions, including Edinburgh Castle, Holyrood Palace and the Royal Mile. We are located on the main bus routes and, with a stop literally outside our front door, we could not be better placed for access to and from host families and activity locations. The area is famous for its connection with Sherlock Homes. Sherlock Homes' statue is five minutes walk from the school.

Scotland has breathtaking and stunning scenery a unique history, castles and lochs, it's own monster - The Loch Ness Monster and Edinburgh is the birth place of Harry Potter.

THE PROGRAMME

The programme is offered to overseas families who wish to combine a family holiday in Scotland with language learning and cultural experiences.

The programme can be booked for TWO or THREE weeks, Sunday to Sunday.

The overseas families, as a group, will be met at Edinburgh International airport and transfered to Host Family accommodation. Each overseas family will stay with the same Host.

The adults and children (aged 12 to 17 years) will have seperate bedrooms and facilities will be shared with the Scottish family. The host accommodation will provide breakfast and evening meal each day. Packed lunches will be provided for the full day sightseeing trips. A lunch voucher will be provided each day, Monday to Friday. A local travel bus pass will be included in the cost. Children will undertake 3 hours per day of English language lessons in a closed group, Monday to Friday (15 hours per week). The parents/family members will have every morning free, Monday to Friday. At lunch time the parents and the children will come together at the school and go for lunch at a nearby restaurant. On two afternoons per week the family will form a tourist group and with a guide undertake walking tours of Edinburgh. On a weekend day the family will form a tourist group and with a guide undertake a full day sightseeing trip each week. The family can enjoy the history and stunning scenery of Scotland on these family outings. In the evenings parents and children are free to stay with their host family and experience Scottish family living or explore the city at night as a family on their own.

OPTIONS FOR PARENTS

Options are available for the parents during the mornings such as learning english, attending the schools adult classes or undertaking additional sightseeing trips. Contact the school to discuss the various options available and the extra costs.

A two-day trip is offered to the Scottish Highlands with overnight accommodation in a dormitory, to ride on the Hogwart Express Train that Harry Potter used. The cost for this trip is £240 pounds per person.
