



Our summer school takes place at Chesterton Community College: a newly-extended and refurbished secondary school in a near-central location with excellent on-site facilities.

In addition to modern teaching and breakout spaces, students can enjoy a selection of hot and cold lunch items served in the newly built school dining hall.

Parents and children study on the same site; adult and junior timetables are synchronised to allow families to arrive at and depart school together.

Our summer centre is easily accessed by bike or bus from all areas of Cambridge. The historic city centre is just a 15-20 minute walk away.

WHO CAN JOIN?

Our summer school welcomes children and young adults aged 5–19 years. Children are placed into classes from Early Learners (5-9) to Juniors (10-11) then Teens 12-15, appropriate to their age and level of English. Students aged 16-19 join our adult classes.

Parents can join in the fun too! Just choose from one of our adult programmes on pages 9-13. You can join selected afternoon activities with your children if you like, as well as our regular family evenings.



Our most popular course option is our full-day programme which includes:

- 20 lessons/15 hours of English lessons in the morning
- A choice of hot & cold lunch items from the school dining hall
- 4 afternoon activities and 1 half-day excursion
- 2 evening activities (optional)

If you really want to maximise your English and are aged 14+, you can add afternoon 1:1 lessons.

- Choose 2,3,4 or 5 afternoons per week
- Lunch is included on days you have lessons

Can't come to school in the afternoon? If you can't stay with us all day, it is possible to join our morning lesson only sessions – see our Dates & Prices for details.

LESSONS

Lessons are designed to be engaging and relevant to each age group. We use modern books, internet based resources, real-life materials of all kinds, and do project work that often involves going out of the classroom and meeting English people. The teachers are young but well-qualified and experienced, and know how to make learning fun as well as effective.

One of the main advantages of coming to our summer school is the opportunity to learn 'real English' and to improve confidence and fluency. You will find all our staff, both teachers and activity leaders very happy to talk to you and spend time with you.

Early Learners (5-9 years) join classes run by teachers with direct experience of this age group. We aim to introduce the children to English through a programme of active learning where they begin to experience the language by working and playing together. They are introduced to the essentials of the language through music, specially devised games, and art and craft. These students have both a teacher and teaching assistant in each class.

Juniors & young teens are usually most interested in starting to use the English they are learning at school, building up confidence and learning lots of new words. Our teachers provide lots of opportunities to practise speaking and listening, and plan the lessons to stimulate students, using video, music and project work. Although the lessons are fun, our teachers carefully plan the courses to ensure that lessons are balanced and individual needs are being met.

Older teens (16+) join our adult classes in the mornings. They will use a lot of authentic materials on current topics as a basis for the work in these classes and as a starting point for discussion, writing exercises, group presentations and so on. At this age, students may be facing important exams and we can help students with any problems they may be having.







A range of fun and engaging activities, with something for everyone, from sports to arts. Activities are differentiated for our different age-groups, including Young Adults, 16-19 years old.

Activities are led by our team of trained and experienced activity leaders. All transport and admission fees are included in the price. Activities end at 15:45, except on Wednesdays, when we return at 17:00.

NEW FOR 2021

We now offer a choice of afternoon activities for adults of all ages. Activities are available to book on an ad hoc basis at reception.



When you study Total English you will learn modern 'Standard English' which will help you communicate easily with people all over the world in all situations from work to holiday.

You will study in a small group, maximum 12 students and work on all your skills - reading, writing, speaking and listening - with other students at your level. Having a good level of General English is the essential base for communication in all areas of life, professional and personal.

The course consists of 20 lessons (15 hours) of tuition which takes place in the mornings.

How it works:

The mornings are divided into four lessons with a 15 minute break in between. You change teachers at break but we aim to keep the same two teachers working with you long term.

Lessons 1 & 2:

In lessons 1 & 2 you will use the main coursebook, which will provide the framework of your course with a range of additional materials to make your lessons interesting and relevant. Our small groups give you plenty of opportunities to discuss topics with your teacher and classmates.

Lessons 3 & 4:

Lessons 3 & 4 are more flexible, and provides space for extended speaking and listening practice, and development of topics from Lessons 1 & 2.



TOTAL ENGLISH PLUS

Total English Plus gives you the opportunity to study more intensively, focusing on whatever is most important to you; passing an exam, writing business reports, improving your pronunciation... it's your time and the choice is yours.

This course consists of 20 lessons (15 hours) studying in group classes, Monday - Friday plus your choice of either:

- 2 x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English + 4)
- 3 x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English + 6)
- 4 x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English + 8)
- 5 x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English + 10)

ONE-TO-ONE

If you need to make progress fast, have a special interest that can't be covered in group lessons, or just a busy life, One-to-One teaching could be the answer. A course and a teacher just for you: any level, any skill, professional or personal – your course, you choose.

How it works:

When you enquire, tell us that you want One-to-One lessons and if possible what you want to study. We'll always advise you if you're not sure, and discuss the options with you. When you register, you will be asked to complete the usual Assessment Test, together with a Needs Analysis Questionnaire. This will give us more information to start planning your course. At all times well keep in touch and ask you for more information if necessary to provide the best course. When you start your course, you will meet with your tutor and agree your goals and the initial study plan to help you achieve them. Feedback sessions are built into the course, and the study plan can be modified at any point by agreement between you and your tutor.

Course Options:

Immersion Courses

- 20 lessons (15 hours) per week
- 30 lessons (22.5 hours) per week
- 10 lessons (7.5 hours) per week afternoons only
- One-to-one on demand 2-8 lessons (1.5 6 hours) per week afternoons only

Immersion courses will take place at our year-round school in Cambridge's historic University Quarter.







SUMMER GROUP COURSES

CLOSED GROUPS

Closed groups study in our year-round school located in The Cambridge Union Society. This iconic building is situated in the University Quarter at the heart of Cambridge.

INTERNATIONAL CLASSES
