When you study Total English you will learn modern 'Standard English' which will help you communicate easily with people all over the world in all situations from work to holiday.

You will study in a small group, maximum 12 students and work on all your skills - reading, writing, speaking and listening - with other students at your level. Having a good level of General English is the essential base for communication in all areas of life, professional and personal.

The course consists of 20 lessons (15 hours) of tuition which takes place in the mornings.

The mornings are divided into four lessons with a 15 minute break in between. You change teachers at break but we aim to keep the same two teachers working with you long term.

Lesson 1 & 2:

In lessons 1 and 2 you will use the main coursebook, which will provide the framework of your course with a range of additional materials to make your lessons interesting and relevant. Our small groups give you plenty of opportunities to discuss topics with your teacher and classmates.

Lesson 3 & 4:

Lessons 3 and 4 is more flexible, and provides space for extended speaking and listening practice, and development of topics from lessons 1 and 2.



TOTAL ENGLISH PLUS

Total English Plus gives you the opportunity to study more intensively, focusing on whatever is most important to you; passing an exam, writing business reports, improving your pronunciation... it's your time and the choice is yours.

This course consists of 20 lessons (15 hours) studying in group classes, Monday - Friday, plus your choice of either:

- 2 afternoons x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English Plus 4)
- 3 afternoons x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English Plus 6)
- 4 afternoons x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English Plus 8)
- 5 afternoons x 2 one-to-one lessons per week (Total English Plus 10)

ONE-TO-ONE

If you need to make progress fast, have a special interest that can't be covered in group lessons, or just a busy life, One-to-One teaching could be the answer. A course and a teacher just for you: any level, any skill, professional or personal – your course, your choice.

How it works:

When you enquire, tell us that you want One-to-One lessons and, if possible, what you want to study. We'll always advise you if you're not sure, and discuss the options with you. When you register, you will be asked to complete an Assessment Test, together with a Needs Analysis Questionnaire. This will give us more information to start planning your course. At all times we'll keep in touch and ask you for more information if necessary to provide the best course. When you start your course, you will meet with your tutor and agree your goals and the initial study plan to help you achieve them. Feedback sessions are built into the course, and the study plan can be modified at any point by agreement between you and your tutor.

Course Options:

Immersion Courses

- 20 lessons (15 hours) per week
- 30 lessons (22.5 hours) per week
- 10 lessons (7.5 hours) per week afternoons only
- One-to-one on demand 2-8 lessons (1.5 6 hours) per week afternoons only

Immersion courses will take place at our year-round school in Cambridge's historic University Quarter.


HOW IT WORKS

Before you enrol on the course we will ask the whole family to take an assessment test, and to tell us something about your interests, and any specific language areas that you'd each like to work on.

You will choose your programme, and the length of your stay. The minimum stay is one week and there are both morning only and morning + afternoon options.

Every day is different and the course can evolve as you discover new things around you that you want to explore or things you would like to study in more detail.

The course can incorporate both learning inside the classroom but also can involve time out of the classroom in real life situations depending on your specific requirements and needs.

WHAT WILL I DO?

Your teacher will guide you in exploring the living language in context. Learning activities, inside and outside the classroom, are designed to stimulate and involve adults and children alike.

Working together on shared projects, children benefit from the support of their grown-ups, while the adults are encouraged to look afresh at the language they already know. Constant interaction with the teacher aids development of realistic patterns of speech and expands vocabulary.


The courses are tailored to the profile of each family, using specifically-designed materials to reflect their interests and levels of English - they are not reliant on coursebooks.

GROUP COURSES

As well as courses for adults, children and families, at ABC Languages we operate specialist courses for closed groups.

Group study is an excellent way of bringing people together to achieve their common goal. Our school is popular with groups from visiting schools, corporate groups and groups of friends.

The minimum stay is one week and groups can stay for as many weeks as they like.

Closed groups study in our year-round school located in The Cambridge Union Society. This iconic building is situated in the University Quarter at the heart of Cambridge.

Studying in closed classes allows groups to choose exactly what topics they would like us to focus on when being taught. Lessons are tailored to the groups specific requirements, whether it be general English, exam preparation, business courses, the choice is yours!

In addition, closed groups can choose their own schedule of activities and excursions - the programme is tailormade to the groups requirements.
