

## **Information**

LINES has been established in the UK since 1995. Downe House is LINES' longest running centre in the UK. Downe House is based in the beautiful county of Berkshire, home to the family of the current Duchess of Cambridge, Kate Middleton. Kate is herself a former pupil of Downe House.

Downe House is approx. 45 min from Heathrow airport, 60 min from London and 30 min from Oxford. The school is located in the village of Cold Ash where it is surrounded by beautiful countryside. It is built on secured grounds with private access.



LINES offers a personalised meet and greet service from and to the airport. LINES takes responsibility for the welfare of each student from arrival until departure.

LINES offers a summer intensive English program at Downe House. The program accepts beginners to advanced levels. The age ranges from 6-18. LINES has 4 main groups: Kids, Teens, Juniors and Seniors.

LINES has an international mix of students. Emphasis is on complete immersion. The program is residential so all students and staff remain on campus.

# Workshops

Workshops are a very important part of the LINES experience. 2 x 45 min are dedicated to workshops per day.

Students can choose from Option A or Option B but must undergo that particular workshop for 1 week after which they can change. Students must select their workshop for the first week of their stay during the enrolment stage.

Option B will need a minimum of 4 students for the workshop to take place. Those that will choose Option B must complete an assessment. This assessment will be sent by the LINES office and must be returned prior to the student arriving in the UK.

**Teens:** Option A (Film Production, Popular Music, Drama, Everyday English, Fashion Design and Health & Fitness). Option B (Best of Britain, min level B1.1)

Juniors & Seniors: Option A (Film Production, Popular Music, Drama, Everyday English, Journal & Creative Writing, Fashion Design and Health & Fitness). Option B (Exam Preparation, no min level required, Best of Britain, min level B1.1, Debate Society, Business English min level B1.4)


