

Conditional Offers of Acceptance (ESL + post-secondary program) are available for those who meet all other academic requirements aside from English, and are interested in applying to a post-secondary program.

The ESL program places emphasis on the four major communicative and academic skills: listening/speaking, reading, writing and grammar. Our programming is based on the nationwide Canadian Language Benchmarks.
