Teaching

At SUL, it is very important to us that students benefit linguistically from their stay in the UK. All courses therefore include work on language that students will need to use on their programmes, whether language to communicate with host families, language to go shopping or language to participate in team building activities.

Educational Visits SUL English through Experience

The SUL English through Experience programme is popular with primary school groups looking to enrich their year-round studies on topics such as British history and literature. The educational visits are the main focus of the course. The morning 'link lesson' prepares students for the things they are going to be seeing and doing and also involve practice of relevant language structures and vocabulary.

We work with the group's organiser and take care to ensure the visits are as educational as possible. Students have guided tours of the points of interest and complete tasks to ensure that learning is taking place. The evening activities promote communication and relate to the educational visit of the day, helping both the English and the visit become more memorable.

Course Objectives: To improve English by 'doing' while engaged in educational visits and activities. To develop a wider understanding of aspects of British history, literature and traditions covered in students' year-round school curricula.

Educational Visits SUL English for School Subjects

It is more and more important for students to be able to communicate in English on a range of subjects, with many schools adopting a CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning) approach to teach English and subject content simultaneously.

On a SUL English for School Subjects programme we can work with your school's curriculum to teach English for school subjects including Maths, Science, Geography or History. We can also provide programmes on more specific subjects such as Medicine, Engineering or Art for higher-level secondary groups.

We link the educational visits and activities to the English tuition, providing a well-rounded experience. For example, an English for Maths programme may include a London walking tour incorporating the geometric shapes of famous buildings and bridges.

Programmes include guided project preparation on the specific subject to promote teamwork and independent learning. Students give their project presentations at the end of the course, which also develops their English public speaking skills.

Course Objectives: To promote integrated learning by linking a curriculum subject to English lessons, activities and visits.



Example programme: This English for Science programme is based at our Great Ballard residential centre (see locations pages). This course is aimed at a primary group and can be adapted for older groups, other academic subjects or alternative locations. Please enquire for more information.

Language Holidays SUL Exciting English Explorer

If a fun experience is just as important to your students as English improvement, the SUL Exciting English Explorer could be just what you need. Students have English lessons each morning with topics relating to the afternoon activity, which helps them to remember the language more clearly.

The project work throughout the course provides students with an opportunity to use their English creatively. SUL Language Holidays usually last for 2 weeks and students give their project presentations at the end of the course.

Most popular for teenage groups, this course is best taken as a homestay option, meaning students practise their language skills when interacting with the host and their family.






