UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

UTK's admission process is competitive. Complete application information is at:

Important information:

1) Apply and pay the application fee online. https:// vip.utk.edu/default.asp

2) Your official records and transcripts of all previous academic institutions must be reviewed and submitted by an agency such as WES or ECE.

3) If your native language is not English, you must submit a TOEFL score of 70 (iBT) or IELTS score of 6.5 (see website above for other options).

4) SAT or ACT scores are not required EXCEPT for engineering applicants.

5) Write a personal statement and request recommendation letters.

6) There are additional requirements for architecture, engineering, and nursing admission.

Conditional admission is available to students who meet undergraduate admission requirements except for English proficiency. Students admitted conditionally must enroll in UT's English Language Institute.

GRADUATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Prospective graduate students should review departmental application requirements on each department's website. Most departments require submission of test scores such as GRE or GMAT and recommendation letters. Prospective students are encouraged to contact the academic department prior to submitting an application.

2) Submit official or attested records and transcripts of all previous academic institutions, with certified translations if records are not in English.

3) If your native language is not English, you must submit a TOEFL score of 80 (iBT) or IELTS score of 6.5 (see website above for other options).
