ASSESSMENT AND PROGRESS*

With The Language Gallery you'll always know how you're progressing. You start your lessons on the day of your arrival so there are no delays to your learning.

Weekly assessments and meetings (tutorials) with your teacher will help you focus on what you do well and what you need to improve.

If you and your teacher feel you are ready to move to the next level of study, you can take the level test at any time – and if you score 80% or higher, you can move to the next level the following week.







CORE CLASSES

Our core classes include 20 lessons per week (15 hours) and will give you confidence in your speaking skills. For a more intensive course, choose 25 lessons per week (18.75 hours) by adding 5 elective classes. This will build on your learning from the core classes. Electives change regularly so you'll have lots of different topics to choose from.

IELTS EXAM PREPARATION

These exams are recognised worldwide as proof of English for academic purposes. IELTS is used for visa requirements in many countries.

You will develop the English language skills and exam techniques necessary to prepare for the IELTS exams. Our preparation programme focuses on your goals, helping you develop strategies to achieve a better score.

You will take weekly practice tests and have regular meetings to see how you're doing with the class.

Our experienced teachers will guide you through the complexities of modern working life. By taking this course, you will develop the skills and confidence to interact in all workplace situations.

LESSONS: 20 lessons (UK) / 10-40 lessons (Canada)*
DURATION: Minimum 1 week

TOEFL iBT EXAM PREPARATION

Develop the skills to succeed in the TOEFL iBT exam. This exam is recognised by over 9,000 organisations around the world, including the governments of Canada, the USA, and Australia. It is used for higher education or as evidence of your English level for migration or work.

Our TOEFL iBT course will help you develop the English language skills and strategies necessary to prepare for the TOEFL iBT exam. As well as providing a goal-oriented, focused preparation programme, the course contains regular testing and tutorials with your teacher to monitor and discuss your progress.

UNIVERSITY PATHWAY PROGRAMMES



ENGLISH LANGUAGE

The University Pathway Programme (UPP) course is designed to prepare you for university life in Canada or the UK, giving you an in-depth look at what they expect.

You'll develop the key skills required for studying in English at an undergraduate or postgraduate level, as well as receive regular assessments and feedback to help you succeed.

Depending on the university, this programme can be a substitute for an external English language exam such as IELTS.

You will:

- Focus on academic skills including essay writing, research methods, and critical thinking
- Prepare for independent academic study at an English-speaking university
- Practice listening to lectures, note-taking, reading, and summarising
- Learn how to deliver an academic presentation
- Improve your study, research, and critical thinking skills

This programme is also useful for students who already have a place at a university, or who want to keep their options open but still wish to prepare for studying in an English-speaking country.

START DATES: Module 1 every Monday except public and bank holidays, with specific start dates for Module 2 (please refer to our website).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

A0 Beginner – C1 Advanced

DURATION: Minimum 8 weeks (30 lessons)


