GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT

We make sure that there is a wide mix of students from different countries on our summer school. For a better immersion experience, we include some British teenagers on our activity programme. We also limit the number of students from each country and the number of speakers of each language.

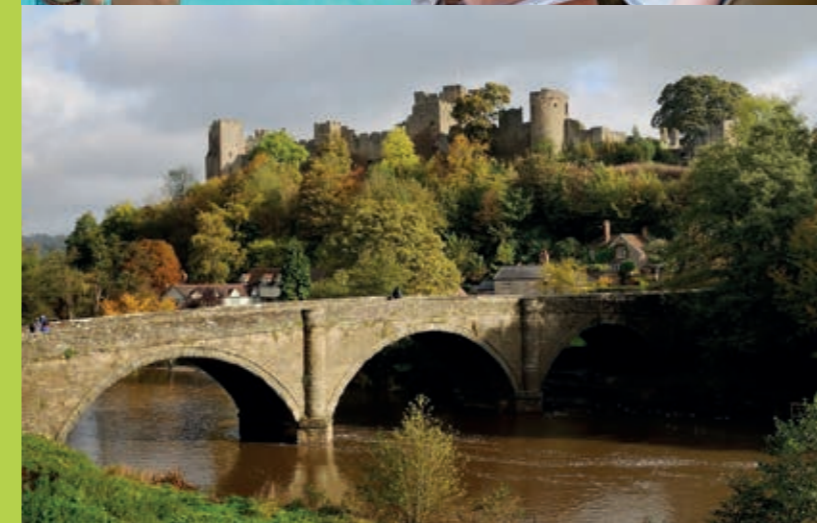
THE CAMPUS

The learning

Our teaching programme is designed to inspire, motivate and support students

We use active teaching methods that engage children because we know that children who are challenged and who are enjoying their lessons work harder and learn more. **Classes are divided according to age, level and first language.**

Mornings: Core English

15 hours a week, 3 hours a day

The aim of **Core English** is for students to become more confident and fluent, ready to use English in life, study and work in the future.

These lessons include:

- ✓ Speaking, listening and pronunciation
- ✓ Writing: essays, reports, articles, blogs and more
- ✓ Grammar: with the focus on practice
- ✓ Collaborative group work: sharing ideas and supporting each other
- ✓ Motivating tasks: interviews, presentations and discussions
- ✓ Cross-curricular focus on subjects like maths, science and business
- ✓ A vocabulary review during the week and at the end of every week

- We accept students who have **Pre-intermediate level (A2) English and above.**
- **All students do the Oxford Online Placement Test prior to arrival.**



Academic focus

For learners with English level B2 to C2 there is a special focus on academic skills.

Get Ahead options: included



Every child is different with different 'goals' and ambitions. Our Get Ahead options motivate students by giving them the opportunity to use their English in enjoyable and challenging new ways. We offer a wide range of creative, sports and academic choices suitable for students with English levels from Pre-intermediate (A2) to Proficiency (C2).

All options are for one week, except for Shakespeare, and you can book a new option for every week if you want to. Choose from:

1. Get Ahead Leadership

Excellent preparation for studying at a UK university.

- **Business Challenge:** students develop teamwork and presentation skills by designing, pitching and selling a new product competitively.
- **Speech Making:** by studying famous speeches, students learn how to use language to persuade an audience.
- **Model United Nations:** working in teams students learn to research and formally debate global issues.

2. Get Ahead Intensive English

Boost your exam grade with our **Cambridge PET** and **FCE** preparation classes.

Learn English all day long

Learning English never stops:

- students have meals with staff
- professional sports coaching involves a language learning element
- on excursions students listen to live commentaries

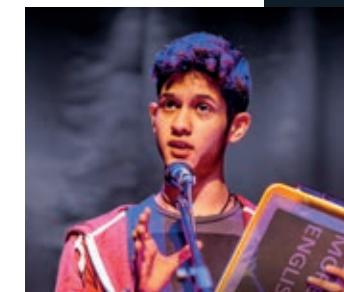
We have designed the programme so that students use English throughout the day



3. Get Ahead Performing Arts

Dance, film, act or take a 'behind the scenes role' producing and directing. There are 3 choices available:

- **Dance choreography**
- **Drama and theatre**
- **Film making**



4. Get Ahead Professional Sports Coaching

Professional sports coaching in **tennis**, **football** or **golf**. Students not only develop their sports skills, but also improve their English by interacting with others in a real life situation. They also learn team skills.



5. Get Ahead Creative English

Shakespeare: discover love, ambition, rivalry and revenge as you make your journey into the world of Shakespeare. You will study a complete play.

Creative writing: students learn the skill of writing short stories from generating ideas to clever descriptions of atmosphere and character.



Song writing: If you love pop, rock or rap, this option is for you. Learn what makes a great song and write your own.



There is also the option of **1:1 English lessons**, **1:1 tennis** and **1:1 golf** so that students can focus on those particular areas they want to improve in.



DO MORE: Full-day excursions

We include 1 full-day and 1 half-day excursion every week in the price. The Excursion Programme offers the perfect chance to experience UK culture, meet British people and practise English.

Warwick Castle with Stratford

A spectacular day out at Warwick Castle: students experience one of the scariest dungeons in England. They also visit Stratford, home of William Shakespeare, possibly the greatest writer in the English Language.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

- **Coach transfers** are available from Birmingham (recommended) and Heathrow between these times:
Flights arriving: 11:00 - 16:00
Flights departing: 12:00 - 17:00
- **Taxi transfers** are available from: Birmingham (the nearest), Heathrow, East Midlands, Liverpool, Bristol, Manchester, Luton and Gatwick.

STAFF AT THE AIRPORT

On transfer days our staff are always in the airport wearing More Than English t-shirts. Our staff meet your child in the arrivals hall. On departure day, our staff take your child to the airport and assist your child with check in. We recommend booking an Unaccompanied Minor (UM) service direct with the airline.



PARENT TRANSFER OPTION

Parents are most welcome to bring their children to the school themselves.
