The Details

Global Leadership Academy classes will be held 9:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday-Thursday, July 5 through July 25 on the Missouri State University campus in Springfield, Missouri. Fridays will consist of optional morning computer lab time and service learning projects in the afternoon.

Resident youth will live on campus in a dormitory and eat in the dining halls. Domestic students may choose either a resident or commuter option.

Costs

3-Week Global Leadership Academy

Resident Youth* (domestic or international, includes 3 meals per day, 7 days per week)	\$2,000
Commuter Youth* (domestic only, includes 2 meals per day, lunch and choice of breakfast or dinner Monday-Thursday)	\$800
Chaperone** (international only)	\$1,200

*Participants must be at least 12 years of age. There is an expectation of excellent behavior and academic skills for all participants, regardless of age.

**International groups must provide their own chaperones. Contact for details.
