ENGLISH LESSONS & CLUBS

English Classes are approximately 12 hours of study per week and curriculum studied will be determined by both age and English ability. Whereas both groups will study the fundamental skills needed to master any language, such as listening, speaking, grammar, reading, writing and pronunciation, the more advanced students will include goal setting and will have curriculum based around leadership skills. Clubs are an opportunity for students to develop their English while practicing and learning other new skills. Students will choose to either join our athletics program or our artistic program. In each of these, the students will begin by practicing skills related to the club and then have the opportunity to put their skills into use, whether it be through competition in athletic clubs or presentations of their works in the artistic clubs.
