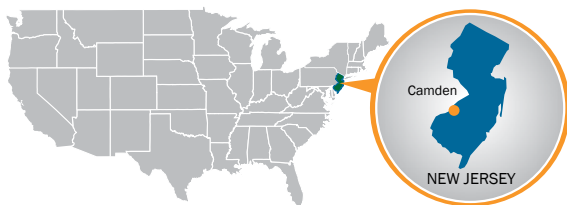

ABOUT CAMDEN, NEW JERSEY



Rutgers–Camden is located on the Delaware River, directly across from the heart of historic Philadelphia, the fifth largest city in the U.S.A. Public transportation is plentiful as are opportunities to enjoy music, theatres, museums, professional sports, shopping and restaurants. The campus is conveniently located just two hours from New York City, two and a half hours from Washington, D.C. and one hour from Atlantic City. Philadelphia International Airport is just 20 minutes from campus.

Rutgers–Camden is nestled within the Camden Waterfront and the Cooper Grant historic neighborhoods. The Camden Waterfront, also known as the Central Waterfront, is a tourist and entertainment district. The waterfront neighborhood is characterized by its visitor attractions and its location offering views of the river and the Philadelphia skyline. The Cooper Grant historic District, a contemporary residential neighborhood, is listed on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places.

Rutgers–Camden is very accessible by public transportation. Local transportation options include:

- NJ TRANSIT RIVER LINE LIGHT RAIL SYSTEM – runs from Camden to Trenton, New Jersey, the state capital
- PATCO SPEEDLINE – offers easy access from southern New Jersey to Philadelphia
- NJ TRANSIT BUSES – stop only a few blocks from campus
- RUTGERS–CAMDEN SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE – makes regular stops around the university campus
- WATERFRONT CONNECTION SHUTTLE BUS – offers easy access during the summer between the Camden Waterfront and Philadelphia
- RIVERLINK FERRY – offers seasonal service between Penn’s Landing in Philadelphia and the Camden Waterfront

Day Trips/Weekends Away: The campus is two hours from New York City, two and a half hours from Washington, D.C., and less than one hour from Atlantic City on the Jersey shore, giving plenty of options for fun weekends away.

ELS LEVELS CHART

ELS offers 12 levels of instruction designed to address the needs of students across the spectrum of English proficiency—from those coming to ELS with the most basic of skills to students with greater fluency who are just steps away from entering a college or university program. The 12 levels build upon one another like a pyramid, relying on the foundation of skills learned at lower levels and moving upward in complexity as the levels increase.

Options for higher education become available to you as you move up the pyramid, providing you with opportunities to put your newly acquired skills to work in ways that help you reach your goal of admission to a college or university.

With every level you progress up the pyramid, you are closer to reaching the pinnacle of the ELS program:

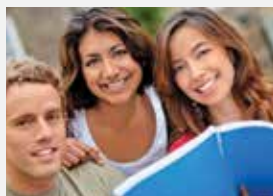

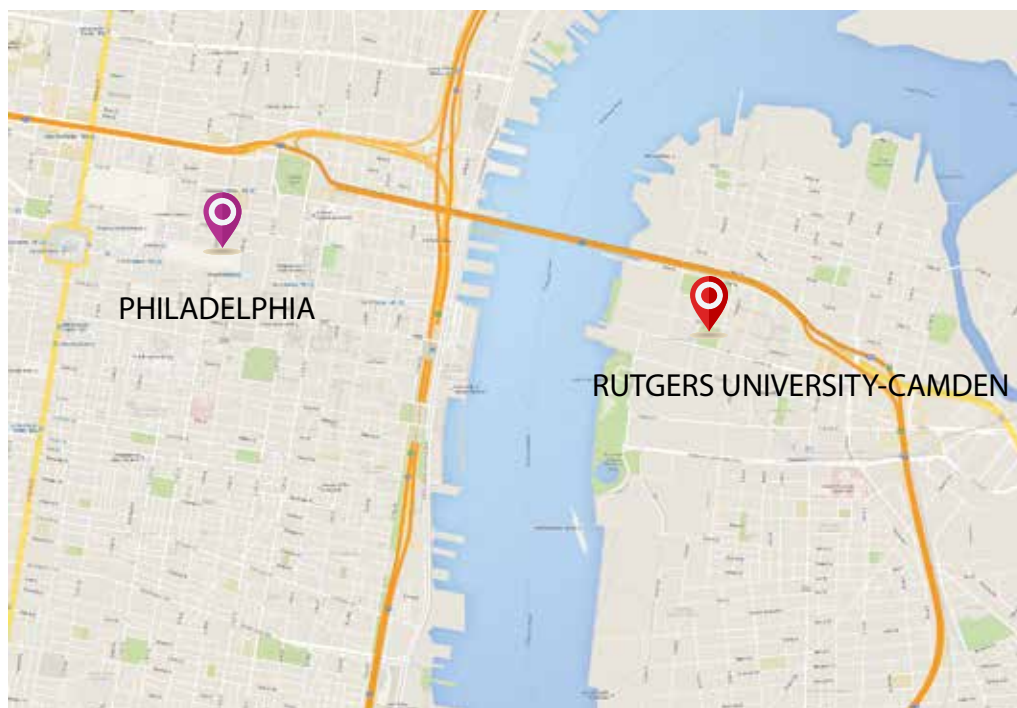
