- 6 Outdoor beauty: Residents of Sioux Falls enjoy the city's four distinct seasons, which allow for a variety of outdoor activities. Falls Park, a 123acre park in downtown Sioux Falls, is complete with some of the city's original buildings, a farmers market, trails for walking or bicycle riding and, of course, the falls themselves, moving over 7,000 gallons of water per second.
- 7 Music, arts and culture: Take a walk through downtown Sioux Falls and enjoy SculptureWalk, a year-round outdoor sculpture exhibit. Browse the art displays and vendors at the annual Festival of Cultures. Visit one of the many history and art museums or enjoy music at a concert. In Sioux Falls, there is an event for every interest.
- 8 Downtown Sioux Falls: With a metropolitan area of more than 250,000, Sioux Falls is the largest city in the state of South Dakota. Augustana University's location in central Sioux Falls places students within walking distance of restaurants, grocery stores, entertainment, and more. Students ride the city bus system for free and enjoy the extensive system of bike trails near campus.

International students benefit from Augustana's small class sizes (average is 17 students), a low student:professor ratio (11:1), and lots of personalized advising, excursions, and activities.
