COURSEWORK

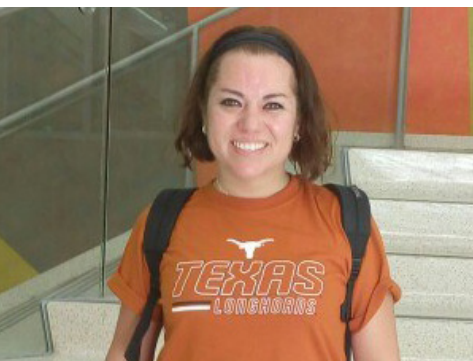
Program coursework consists of intensive classroom instruction in English language and EFL training as well as special opportunities for professional development and cultural immersion.
