THE CENTRE

Entrelenguas is located in a restored building in the Barrio San Francisco, one of the most traditional and historic areas in our city, a stone's throw from the main sites of interest in Ronda. Relaxed, quirky and modern, our centre is host to classes, activities, a shop, a terrace, a pool and free WiFi! Everyone and anyone is welcome to visit our centre!

AN EXTRAORDINARY SETTING

The warmth of its people, its excellent climate and its extraordinary location make Ronda the ideal place to surround yourself in Spanish culture. Thanks to the Romans, Moors and Christians, the city is home to many important cultural sites left behind by each of these different civilisations. Most famous of all is the 18th century 'Puente Nuevo' (New Bridge) over the 100m deep canyon which bisects the two areas of the city.

RONDA HAS IT ALL

In the more modern part of the city you'll find lively Spanish bars, the main shopping streets and the more urban side of Ronda. In contrast, the old town, much more tranquil, is notable for its beautiful narrow streets, unexpected hidden corners and white-washed houses. With a plethora of museums and other cultural sites, there's plenty to see and do in this unique place.

IN THE HEART OF ANDALUSIA

Surrounded by 'pueblos blancos' (white towns) and beautiful mountains, Ronda is situated in the south of Spain, in the Andalusian province of Malaga. Only 45 minutes away from the sunny Costa del Sol and two hours from Granada and Seville, its location has been particularly significant historically. As such, Ronda is one of the most representative cities of all the different aspects of Spanish history and culture.

Spanish School

Our Spanish Courses

With a whopping 470 million native speakers, Spanish is the world's second most-spoken language. Never mind being an official language in 20 countries, as well as one of the official languages of the UN, Spanish is the second most-used language on Twitter! In a recent report commissioned by the British Council, entitled 'Languages for the Future,' Spanish was identified as the most important language for British people to learn. In the United States, Spanish is also the second-most popular language (after English, of course!) to learn and speak.

Its sheer popularity and similarity to other romance languages makes Spanish very accessible. We strongly believe that with the right teachers and methodology, learning Spanish is not only enjoyable and rewarding, but easy! Drawing on our wealth of experience in linguistics and education, at Entrelenguas we have designed a variety of 'Spanish as a Second Language' courses that meet the specific needs of our students. All of our courses are taught by native, university-qualified teachers and follow the guidelines set by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

We offer courses at the following levels:

Beginners	A1 (Breakthrough) and A2 (Waystage)
Intermediate	B1 (Threshold) and B2 (Vantage)
Advanced	C1 (Effective Operational Proficiency) and C2 (Mastery)

To complement our in-classroom lessons, we organise different activities carried out in Spanish of varying levels of complexity. Students are therefore able to put their theoretical knowledge into practice outside of the classroom and learn authentic, day-to-day Spanish.



Year-round Courses

Extensive Courses

For expats living in the Serranía

These courses are held year-round and are directed at ex-pats who live seasonally or permanently in Ronda and its surrounding areas, and who are interested in improving their Spanish knowledge and skills for daily use. Extensive classes take place twice a week, each session being of 90 minutes. And (of course!) we provide tasks and homework for the student to complete during their free time.

Extensive classes are centred around the four main language skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening.) The student gains a complete understanding of the language that can then be applied during their day-to-day life in Spain. Lower levels are focused on oral and writing production, as well as the fundamentals of Spanish grammar and vocabulary. Higher levels focus on more formal and socio-cultural aspects of Spanish, language precision and correcting habitual errors in syntax. This type of course is also perfectly compatible with one-to-one classes and with the different events and activities that we organise at Entrelenguas, which all provide an opportunity to practise the language in different, real-life contexts.

Intensive Courses

For students wishing to learn Spanish quickly and effectively

Our intensive Spanish courses are composed of 20 hours spread over the week, 4 hours a day (pausing for a brief and well-deserved break!) from Monday to Friday. These courses are especially aimed at students who want to spend their holidays learning and improving their level of Spanish at an accelerated rate. They're always subject to availability, but we aim to have courses throughout the year, with never more than 8 students per class.

Our classes follow a communicative methodology, with relevant and fun content combining grammar, vocabulary and culture. Lessons are focused on developing the four main linguistic skills (speaking, listening, reading and writing) in order to give the student a much more global and practical understanding of the language.

Students can also combine our intensive courses with participation outside of the classroom in any of our cultural activities, events, workshops and trips that we offer at Entrelenguas. Everything is focused on practising Spanish and wherever possible, meeting the local community, talking in Spanish in authentic contexts.

We encourage all of our students to stay with host families and live a true native life, sharing meals with them and participating in their daily lives! However, we can also help in finding alternative accommodation if this is the desired option.

Volunteering Programme

Make a difference to the community in Ronda

Our volunteering programme is aimed at students who study Spanish and are interested in helping the local community, whilst practising their Spanish in an authentic and real environment. We work with various associations and businesses whose fields include the environment, education, social work and wine production. Participants have a great choice of volunteering experience: working in allotments, local nursery schools and even organic vineyards, or collaborating with associations such as the Red Cross or Proyecto Hombre. Students volunteer for a minimum of 10 hours per week. Entrelenguas may recommend a particular organisation depending on the student's level of Spanish, as in order to fully benefit and contribute to certain programmes a certain level of fluency is required. In line with this philosophy, students stay with host families in Ronda on a full-board basis. The programme is of course supplemented with a formal academic component, comprising of group lessons (2 sessions of 90 minutes per week) and individual lessons (3 hours of one-to-one lessons per week). As well as this, students can participate in the different events and activities that we organise weekly at the school.

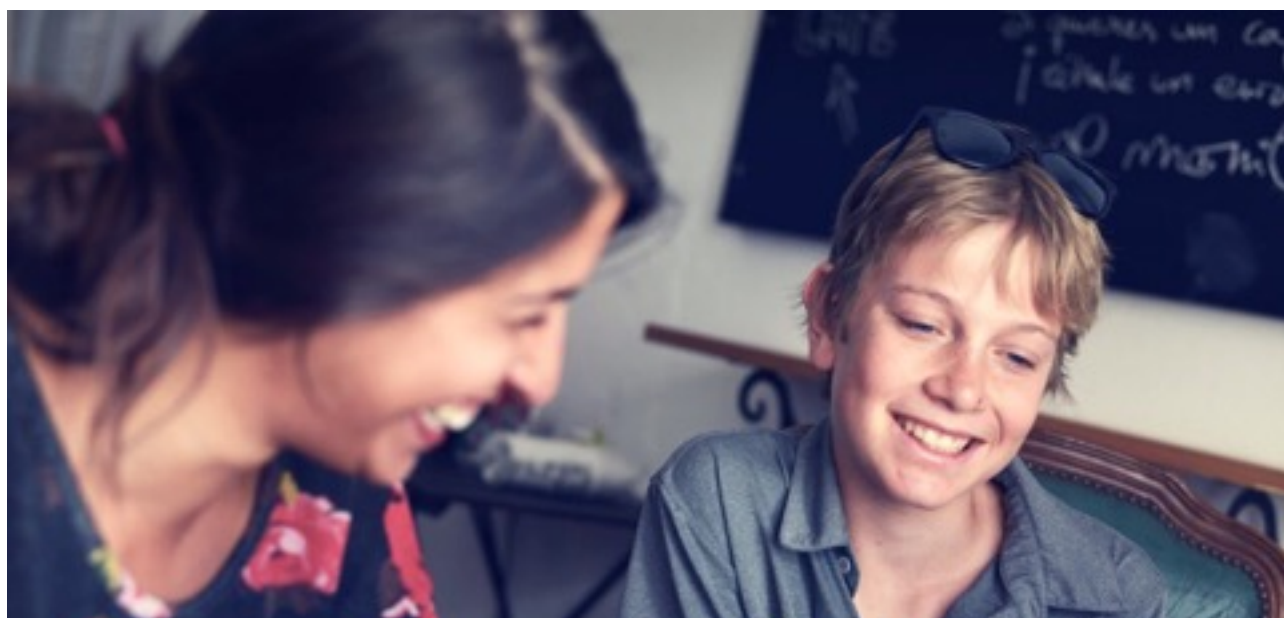

One-to-One Classes

Just you and the teacher

This type of course is perfect for any student who wants to study Spanish with individual attention, at their own pace and without timetabling restrictions. You can work on the specific aspects of the language that you personally need help with (from grammar, vocabulary, speaking, etc) to any other skill that you would like to develop. They're also a great addition to our extensive courses, helping you revise, reinforce or widen knowledge acquired in group classes. The timetabled hours are agreed between the teacher and student and are very flexible, so they can be changed based on the needs and commitments of the student. One-to-one classes are also accompanied by readings, worksheets, essays and other tasks set by the teacher for the student to complete in their spare time.

Summer Courses

Junior Programme

The best way to spend your summer!

Ranging from 1 to 4 weeks in length, our summer courses are the perfect way to improve your Spanish whilst being completely immersed in the real Spain. Enjoy classes led by fully-qualified native teachers, as well as various trips and activities in and around the beautiful Andalusian city of Ronda.

This programme is especially designed for students between 14 and 18 years of age. It focuses on day-to-day cultural immersion in our community. Students combine intensive Spanish classes (20 hours per week) with a full programme of daily activities, weekly workshops and weekend trips that all provide opportunities to practise Spanish outside of the classroom.

The lessons focus on the four key skills of language learning: writing, listening, reading and speaking. Lessons are communicative, fun and relaxed with a variety of games, role-plays, songs and activities.

As if that wasn't enough, the afternoons are full of activities such as hiking, canyoning, museum visits, horse-riding, movie nights and BBQs — there's something for everyone! Students stay with specially selected host families to further increase their immersion in our community. The programme also includes a trip every weekend to one of the various beautiful cities around Andalusia.

University Student Summer Programme

This summer programme offers the best opportunity to learn Spanish and connect with the local community. Complete with activities, events, trips and intensive Spanish classes, this is an authentic experience of Spanish life. Spanish Classes

The programme includes a total of 60 hours of group Spanish lessons: four hours per day, five days a week. Small classes, native teachers and a focus on communication, what's not to like? All learning resources and materials are included.

Granada: This fascinating university city breathes mystery in its very being! We'll visit the Alhambra and meander through the narrow streets of Albaycín with a local guide. They'll explain everything there is to know about the city which has become a centre of art and culture in Andalusia.

Bolonia (Cádiz): In summer we carry the (not so!) arduous burden of being obliged to enjoy the sun and the coast! We'll take you to one of the best beaches the 'Costa de la Luz' has to offer, for a fun-filled day spent chilling out and munching the magnificent food so typical to our region!

Spanish Training for ELE Teachers

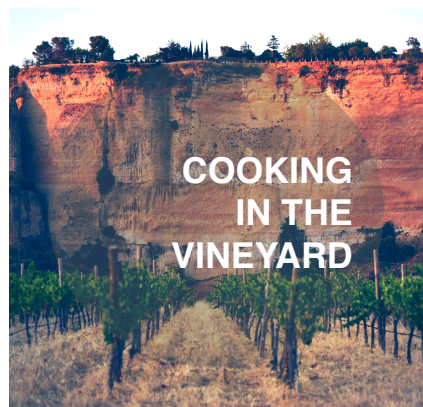
